It also provides school administrators with important accounting background, technique, and applications in the school environment and demonstrates the overall binding effect accounting has on all of the tasks and functions performed by school administrators. Knowledge about accounting and accounting skills pervades all aspects of the day-to-day operation of a school and school district. The proper day-to-day operation of the schools and quality planning and decision-making cannot realistically take place unless administrators and board members have an understanding of school fund accounting. The present and the future will see the need for both financial and managerial accounting. One type will not overshadow the other. Both will continue to evolve and develop to satisfy the needs of society and the education community. Financial and managerial accounting together can be thought of as the process that gathers, produces, organizes, and presents information that can be consumed by a wide variety of users for the purpose of keeping an organization operating, growing, improving, and changing. This book and CD will be useful to superintendents, school business managers, and principals. This book describes recent improvements in governmental accounting, auditing, and financial reporting for school business officials. Applications of financial accounting and reporting principles in typical transactions of school systems are illustrated by questions, cases, and problems at the end of each chapter. The first of the two sections, "Basic Principles of Accounting for Elementary and Secondary School Systems," concerns accounting problems of school systems. Financial accounting and reporting principles are demonstrated by the fund and account group structure as recommended by school business organizations. Attention is focused on problems of cash flow, working capital, and causes of change in financial position of the general fund. This section develops budgetary accounting controls and financial reporting principles. The second section, "Accounting Principles as Applied to the Various Funds Used in

Financial Administration of School Systems," addresses each fund and account group individually, showing how a school's financial structure can be divided into manageable, effective segments. The section includes the general fund, special revenue funds, capital project funds, and debt service funds. Financial transactions typical of those used in each fund and account group of a school system are illustrated. Interim and annual financial statements are given for formal budgetary type funds, and include balance sheets and statements comparing estimated or budgeted revenue with revenue realized. A glossary contains accounting terminology for school systems. Designed as a graduate-level textbook, the book is also a valuable resource for in-service programs. This handbook has been designed as the national standard for state and local education agencies to use in tracking and reporting financial data for school districts to use in preparing their comprehensive annual financial reports (CAFRs). The purpose of the handbook is to ensure that education fiscal data can be reported in a comprehensive manner. The 2009 Edition contains guidance conforming to Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statements, up to Statement 47. There are chapters on budgeting, governmental accounting and financial reporting. Account codes have been updated to reflect changes in the new reporting requirements and developments in technology and security. There are also special chapters on accounting student activity funds and a model for school level program cost accounting. Eight chapters comprise this guide: (1) Introduction; (2) Financial Reporting Within a System of Education Information; (3) Budgeting; (4) Government Accounting; (5) Financial Reporting; (6) Account Classification Descriptions; (7) Cost Accounting and Reporting for Educational Programs; and (8) Activity Fund Guidelines. Appendices include: (1) Summary of Account Code Changes Since 2003; (2) Other Resources; (3) Glossary of Acronyms; (4) Illustrative Financial Statements for an Independent School District; and (5) Criteria for Distinguishing Equipment from Supply Items. (Contains 27 exhibits.). The study researched the experience of treasurers in 15 Ohio public school districts in implementing Governmental Accounting Board Statement No.

34 in the districts' annual financial reports prior to the required implementation date. Statement No. 34 is intended to make government annual financial reports more useful for and comprehensible to members of three user groups---the financial community, legislative and oversight officials, and citizens. In the study, treasurers of the 15 school districts were interviewed regarding their experience in implementing Statement No. 34, the changes in school operations resulting from implementation, and changes in questions from the three user groups about the school districts' finances that resulted from implementation of Statement No. 34. The study found that improving the school districts' fixed asset records was the greatest hurdle in implementing Statement No. 34, school district operations were affected little by implementation, and that questions from the three user groups about school district finances generally did not change after implementation. The majority of treasurers in the study said that Statement No. 34 was not cost-beneficial because there was little evidence that the changes it required were noticed by the three user groups; it provided few, if any, benefits to the school districts; and it increased the school districts' costs of preparing their annual financial reports at a time when many school districts were cutting staff and programs because of revenue shortfalls. To help improve school district financial management, the Association of School Business Officials at its 1980 annual meeting held a special session consisting of 20 "mini-workshops" about successful, field-proven practices in school budgeting, accounting, auditing, and other financial tasks. This document provides summaries of the session based on the "tip sheets" and supporting materials provided by each mini-workshop presenter. In the document's first section, nine presentations are covered on budgeting methods, budget comparisons with other school districts, various accounting methods and applications (including accrual, cash basis, encumbrance, fixed asset, and self-insurance accounting), retirement plan analysis, student activities accounts, and enrollment projections for financial planning. The second section, on auditing and financial reporting, offers 11 mini-workshops on internal and external auditing, fund and property accounting, monthly financial reports, statements of changes in fund balances and financial position, enterprise funds, and revenue and expenditure statements. Each presenter's name, address, and telephone number accompany the workshop material. (Author/RW)
